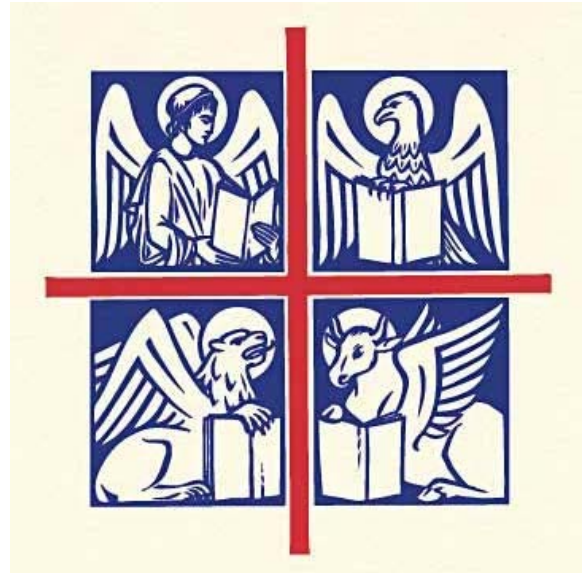


The Crossville Gospel Challenge 1517-2017

Throughout 2017, Christians around the world will be celebrating the 500th anniversary of the Protestant Reformation, which began on October 31st of 1517 by Martin Luther when he nailed his earth-shattering *95 Thesis* to a church door in Wittenberg, Germany. One of the most significant outcomes of the Reformation was the translation of the Sacred Scriptures into languages that could be read and understood by the common man.
